Have the trainee perform the ultrasound examination and make a clinical assessment of the patient's condition (this can be done concurrently). Check the boxes labeled "Yes" or "No" as the student progresses. You may ask the trainee to perform the different exams and to make the clinical assessments listed; however, please do not coach the student or perform parts of the exam yourself.

Note to examiner—patients in the ICU may be difficult or impossible to examine in one or more of the listed views. If the trainee understands proper probe placement and makes a good effort to see the appropriate structures, it should be considered a successful exam.
