
What is NAMHR?

NAMHR was founded to create a place where MH events can be reported in a standardized format, entered into a database, and analyzed.

What is MH?

Malignant hyperthermia is a severe reaction to certain drugs used for anesthesia. Symptoms typically include:

- high body temperature
 muscle rigidity
- rapid heart rate
- muscle breakdown



MH susceptibility is inherited. Children & siblings of someone with MH have a 50% chance of also having an MH reaction.

How do I join?

- Go to anest.ufl.edu/namhr to join the registry online.
- The registry's forms can be filled out online by you and your anesthesiologist/healthcare provider.
